<p>Community Policing</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Strongly in favour of increased visibility of Gardaí equipped with the tools, training and resources they need to do their jobs. 2. On the ground policing in town centres, main streets, public parks, beaches. 3. Visible policing with Gardaí interacting with the community in a positive way at every opportunity. 4. Neighbourhood Watch/Community Safety information sharing meetings. 5. Promoting and developing information links with the Gardaí and with likeminded local community groups. 6. Representatives from Neighbourhood Watch groups coming together in the local Garda Station or suitable venue on a regular basis.

Drugs, bullying, anti-social behaviour, cyber security 13. Together with other relevant fora 14. Educating the public on crime prevention and personal safety.

In order for Text Alert to be successful the relevant Garda Stations need to be 100% committed. 17. At present the level of support varies within the Divisions.

Deterrent by An Garda Síochána to the criminal use of road networks 30. To include CCTV, ANPR, Checkpoints, Intercepts 31. Linking in with 3rd Party Systems e.g. Toll Cameras 32. Facilities enhanced for seizure of vehicles under various Acts. 33. Budgetary support for expenses re vehicle seizures</p>
