## 2. Active Public Consultations and Notices

### Road Limit Speed Limit Order - Rathbeale Road

Chief Executive Order No. OPS/173/19 the Chief Executive of Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), **made the Road Works Speed Limit (no.1) Order (Upgrade works of Rathbeale Road, Swords, Co Dublin) on 15th May 2019 effective until 29th May 2020.** A subsequent Road Works Speed Limit (no.2) Order, which **extended the original speed limit order to 29th May 2021 was executed**; Chief Executive Order No OPS/135/20. It is now proposed to make a further order in request of a road works speed limit for the **Rathbeale Road, Swords, Co Dublin to facilitate upgrade works.**

This Urban Framework Plan seeks to provide a vision for the Donabate town centre which will improve and enhance the Main Street area and guide careful urban improvement. It is envisaged this Plan will highlight the distinctive character of Donabate, its setting on the peninsula, current issues pertinent to Donabate and, lastly, outline a programme of actions which have been agreed with the community.

### Speed Limit Order - Donabate Distributor Road, Donabate, Co Dublin

Notice is hereby given that the Chief Executive, Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers vested in her under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 and having consulted with the Commissioner of An Garda Síochána, has made an order entitled the Road Works Speed Limit (No. 1) Order, Donabate Distributor Road, Donabate, Co. Dublin.

A Road Works Speed Limit of 60km/h will be introduced for the Donabate Distributor Road including the new sections of road linking to the Hearse Road and the Portrane Road (total 4.094km in length) to facilitate completion of road construction works.
