Fingal County Council has commissioned a Coastal Flood and Erosion Risk Assessment Report for the Rogerstown Outer estuary and an Options Report for addressing Coastal Erosion and Flooding at Portrane and Rush . These reports were commissioned in response to significant concerns regarding coastal erosion and coastal flooding in the Burrow Peninsula, Portrane and some of the coastal areas in Rush.

Transboundary Environmental Public Consultation - Sizewell C Nuclear Power Station, Suffolk, UK

Planning Application for proposed Nuclear Power Station at Sizewell C, Suffolk, England, UK, In accordance with the provisions of the 1991 United Nations Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context ("the

Espoo Convention”), the Minister for Housing, Planning and Local Government received notification from the UK Planning Inspectorate (“PINS”) in relation to a development consent application (“the planning application”) by NNB Generation Company (SZC) Limited for a proposed Nuclear Power Station at Sizewell C, Suffolk, England, UK. The proposed development includes two UK European Pressurised Reactor UK EPR™ reactor units, giving a total output capacity of approximately 3,340MW, along with associated development required for the construction and operation of the Sizewell C Nuclear Power Station, including the mitigation of any potential impacts.
