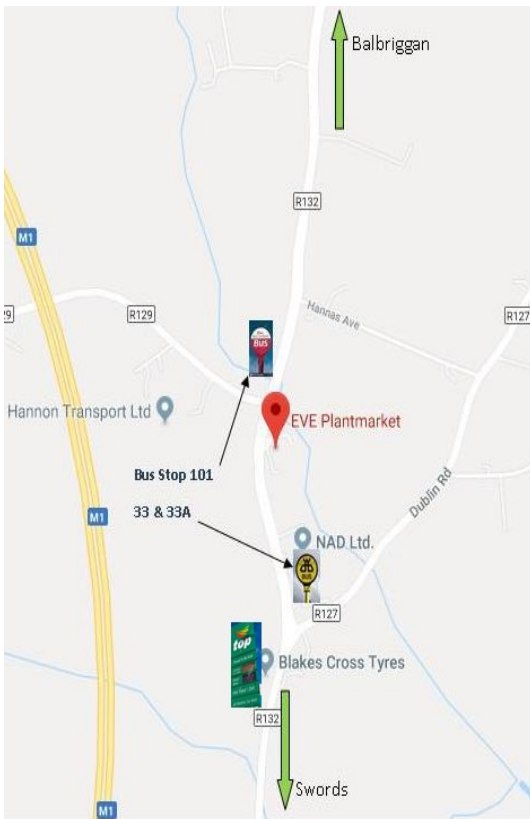


Location

EVE Plantmarket is located approximately 6km past Swords at Blakes Cross on the R132 (Swords—Balbriggan Road).

The Centre is a short distance from the bus stop and is serviced by the number 33/33a Dublin Bus and the 101 bus from Drogheda.



Training allowance

You will receive a weekly allowance as per DDLETB Training allowances (Equivalent to your Disability/Social Welfare Allowance). **These allowances will not affect your additional Social Welfare/Health Service benefits, if applicable. In addition each learner receives a training bonus based on attendance and travel allowance where applicable.**

General Information

Our service is catered towards individuals who have experienced **mental health difficulties** and have the potential to achieve employment and/or progress to further training.

Suitable candidates are individuals who are capable of meeting the training outcomes and have the potential to develop personal practical skills through training. Candidates must be 18 years or over.

Tea/coffee are provided **free** of charge. Personal development and health & wellbeing are incorporated into all programmes. We offer/promote quit smoking programmes in centre.

On completion of training, it is expected that learners will have progressed to one or a combination of the following options:

- To the employment market.
- Progression to mainstream training/education.
- Progression within specialised training.

EVE Plantmarket is a programme in the HSE and is contracted by DDLETB (Dublin Dun Laoghaire Education Training Board) to deliver vocational training in a specialist training environment. We cater to people who have experience of **mental health difficulties**.

Course Objectives

The courses focus on helping learners set goals and work towards achieving them, gain QQI certification, obtain work experience, community integration and to promote independence, self-advocacy and valuable outcomes at the end of their training time.

The courses will provide learners with a QQI qualification and the essential skills to achieve employment and/or progress to further education.

All programmes adhere to stress free learning principals, catering to individual needs, greater time allocation to complete modules. Less exams and more emphasis on portfolio and project work.

In parallel to delivering vocational training EVE Plantmarket delivers a Health & wellbeing programme to support service users to achieve positive long-term behaviour change and to use and develop personal resources and access community supports.

→ Is this for me?

All modules are portfolio based, with less stress on the learner and more emphasis on individual development.



Horticulture

→ Is this for me?
