

Spotlight on... Blakestown Community Centre



Blakestown Community Centre was built in 1987 and is located beside Scoil Mhuire Junior and Senior Schools, on the Hartstown road in the Dublin 15 area.

The centre is open seven days a week (subject to demand) and can cater for a wide range of activities, so there will be something to interest you.

The centre's aim is to be a positive hub for the local community allowing everyone to take part in:

Sport - With a full size indoor sports hall available to hire on request, pictured below.

Leisure - A community coffee shop on site providing reasonably priced tea / coffee and food on site to user groups, local schools and the community.

Community Development - Meeting rooms available to hire for training or activities for all age groups. Additional Facilities include internet access and use of a projector that is included for all room bookings.

Educational and recreational activities - A dedicated youth space within the centre with activities and classes for young people.

Childcare - Community childcare and a pre school service on site.

Feel free to call in for a cup of tea and pick up a time-table and see what activities are taking place. The centre will show you how to book-in for activities. Don't be afraid to try out an event or class for the first time.
